Calves & went to mead &
Grants Ranch stayed
all night Rained some

Arnold - 1 1/2 day to
and sent with cow to
Edmonton came back
to Stones Place third
all night Rained & George
came back from
Dunvallen Potatoes

June 6 Devised three

Pumpkins Peas & Onions
Is up Rained soon this
morning again
Rained 4 o'clock
Cleared up at night
" 7 set to stones and
cut 3 sacks Pat

Onions

June 8 commenced planting
of seeds very warm
John & Landham came
and stayed all night
Waddell went Bear Hunt
9 I broke slim went

his evening 5 for supper

seeds and slim
Brushed the ground
commenced dig in seler
Rained till 4 P.M.

my Bacon Rained a little
Planted 1st Bean & Peas

supper saw 2 swans

Set the Net and Built
a Raft of ice stone called
Hennumbers & up

" 14 went up to Lake
and Built a Raft of
2 ducks & gathered eggs
Stone was up Rained
Waddell went Round Lake

" 15 Rained this morning
Jeremian went to the
Lake to fetch mud hen
Eggs home had eggs
for Breakfast & duck
commenced cutting logs for
shovel went to stone place
stayed all night there
George Stone came up after
Hossis

June 16 I left Stone's Place
with team for Sacketown Lake
to fix up his Baking Flows
Curey & Geo Wet to Probe
for Clifford & get 2 letters
from Annie from Emma
Wet to Sweeds Place fire
Cabbage Plants. Stayed all
Night at ~~Wagon~~ ^{Wagon} Place
gave Mrs \$1.00 for stopping

June 17 Came home with
Grossis to Stone's Place then
came up home back
Rained on me on Road

" 18 Stone came up and
Haled, Hauled Logs and
we had a shower

" 19 Rained all day
we hauled 7 loads off
logs in Rain and got
dinner and plane went
home at 5 o'clock
Rained all night

June 20 Commenced the Log
Shack Laid up 3 1/2 Rounds
of logs Between showers Rained
in the Night Read Pursey ⁱⁿ and in up

Sunday 21 Rained more or less
all day set a Round tent
& Colled a mes of Beans
and kited mes Pot so the milk cant
come in to groceries Nigger Broke the
Picket Rope

" 22 Worked on Cabin ^{Pot}
Wadell saw 3 moose tracks
west of Swan Creek and he
went after them ^{German}

" 23 Wadell German &
I went moose hunting
But did not see them
we set Bear trap west
of Spruce Grove
& I saw Grizzly Bear
track

June 24 I went to Sacetane
Lake Barb Beck an tiger
furgason for dinner stayed
all night Waddell
moved out dont know
where

" 25 Helped Job report and
furgason's house had
dinner took his driving
team and took dillard
home and went to Sewie
Lillo's lustrated 2 horses
& got whip saw I came
to dillard for super & then
drove to furgason stayed
all night

June 26 Bent heater stove
began cattle winds sash
Beans mch oil & grub
Make fire Jeremiah
stayed home at 11.0 clock
stayed at Minkels for

Dinner came to
Stones for the Rain at for
super met home after
super at stones told him
a boat furgason Braking
got team mares wagon
from furgason to work

June 27 Little Head came
up stay to by north dakota
started fore Insqure train
1 pack saddle horse &
left their cut fit hear
we cut saw logs after dinner
we had a nice fish
fish in net fish for super
and grub for break fast
Left potatoes are up to Rain
today since barley this
morning fine day drying
up some mares staying
fine

June 28 Sunday We went to
Stone after Plants & to
grind our axes and he
was just lunning up to
haul Stone logs for
me we wet home and
I plowed out the Road
Down the hill for dinner
and Hauled logs after
dinner I hauled to saw
logs and Stone went
Home after supper he
Brought Prince Horse
up for me to use all
Summer Rather than take
\$100⁰⁰ for him

June 29 finished horse &
put Ridge logs on Indian
visitors leafy

30 put Poles on Ruff and
got it Redy for educt.

July 1 Slim was up after
the little Road was
up after dinner but out
days and windows and based
them. Comenced mudding
Ruff at dinner cant 1,
Hobeled Indian Brants
Road Brought of Bay horse
up for Germain to Ride
very warm and clear
cloudy in west this evening
barely Siewert cause
up with Pack Horse
Hauled mud on Ruff
July 2 Hauled dirt on
Ruff Rained at 4 o
clock thunder storm
crossed creek in Ruff and
water bye cant ground
Hoze in Bear Ruff
wind in south

July 3 Hewed & bunked
the house Rained for
dinner & we cooked dinner
in the new house
showery after dinner

" 4 I fired sunrise
salute 9 men from
united states independent
barricade started
back & I saw 1 at
1 shovel 1 cross cut
saw for \$5.00 from
him We built saw
mill and cut 6 Bords
left head was up after
the fore Rained after
dinner shower & cool
wind

" 5 I set to stones and
Doe to Lins after some cabbage
tomato plant & Beans
Jermain set up the grill
& chatted with some

we

" 6 we sawed 23.8 in
Bords to day Jersey came
up and tried the saw
mill Rained in fore noon

" 7 so we hewed brace
and Layed floor after
dinner we sawed 1 Log 1/2 in
Bords fore fore George Stone
was up hunting birds
we slept in the new house
& moved in and we appreciate
a house once more

" 8 we sawed 7 Bords fore
dinner & cant a cold yester
day am under the weather
Jermain quit me at
11 O'clock to cut his
axe logs he cut 8 logs
and this evening he is looking
up a road to his place
I covered the dirt down in
front of the door so we can
cut in and out looks Raney

July the 9 1908
Went to stumps after hoe
and hauled the garden
" 10 hauled potatoes
very windy & Germain
but trail to his place
" 11 hauled potatoes
Germain but logs
Little Bead Beant
Jacket up Gray
four men came back
from Insouber had supper
with us. Light frost 12th
" 12 we went to stumps
& got team and wagon
& went to Sacklin
Lake visited Fernes
Had strawberries for
dinner there Beant 3rd
Buter stayed at
Furgesons all night

" 13 I sharpened
Plow lay sick &
we set one frame
fore stone at Lake
B. & R. Rail Road
Sivvans camped at
Lake fore dinner we
started home at 3pm
got home at dark
Mr. Dillard came
up with us from
Stony Bloudey looks
like Rain
" 14 Dillard & Germain
Went up the creek after dinner
Rained fore dinner & shop
New saw and slept
" 15 Dillard went back
Home I set up ingwa
and transplanted Beats
& hewed 4 yoice fore
flore & put them in
Rained

July 16 I went to stones
in it wagon ground as
I stayed for dinner came
I found I sawed Potatoes
after dinner very warm
cloudy this evening
Little Read came for
to be

" 17 I finished hewing
spuds & hewed the garden
Read came up after the
Hove I went in swimming
weeded the garden and
cleared brush south of
house

" 18 we cut 7 Boards
and after dinner I cleared
brush of stable ground
Geo stone was up after
Harris

July 19 Had 6 Indian
dinner they were fair more
Hunting Rob Read Stone
and a man from spirit
River came up and brought
some tools & bolts to make
Bull Rake with and
I sent the tent home
& they brought my meat
& Beans & sawdough
and I had and looked for
3/4 of Jermain went
to Wash Lake
to make hay
one brick was up with
stones

" 20 made Bull Rake
Sawed floor Jermain
came back & Geo stone
wet up to Brake and for
them

July 21 I went to ^{10 am} Lower
Place and hoed garden
cleared brush after dinner
2 Indians came back from
Lake had 1 swan ^{10 am}
" 22 I went to Lake &
Jermain's Place fore dinner
hoed brush after dinner ^{10 am}
" 23 Inez came up with
I began cutting hay &
set up rake very warm
rained a little but hay
after dinner ~~made work back~~
" 24 I made work bench
cut hay with Bead Beal
my son Beal & man from
Taterson ^{click} ^{more} partner went to
Jermain's Place rained a
" 25 made Lady fore
saler & Bead steel &
cleared brush to wagon
Place & Boiled Beef.

July 26 windy this morning
Went west cold
I went to stons & had New
Potatoes Jermain went to
Lacklin to hay Geo Stone
stayed all night very cold
" 27 frost this morning
Pot Nipped Geo Stone came
up to rake hay I sent
Hay after dinner cloudy
to night
" 28 Stones came up
and we started the Bull
rake but hay was hot
dry had dinner & it began
to rain Geo ran after his
team all fore noon
a foot but hay on
bench before dinner
hoed the garden & Potatoes
" 29 hoed sheds morning
sent hay after dinner
cloudy & damp

" 30 finished hewing
shnds cut weads Raked
Hay after dinner cloudy
this evening mosquitoes plenty
cut 3 mice last night
July 31 Percy pulled Rickett
stake I went to stons
after being found him on
my Road back Raked
Hay after dinner & Bunch
the Hay cloudy wind
in the East Began
to Rain after dark
very heavy shower
of the season
Yes my Hay is gone
Saturday August
first 1908
Began to Rain at
4 o'clock very
thunder & lightning

Boat Hossis Break
Goss & Goss with
Rickett Hoops went
to the Lake my
hoop leaked like
a sieve I found the
Hossis on Arnold's
Place one Rope gone
Percy came up I
Brought Prince Home
and he broke the Rope
and went to stons
Little Red brought
him back I more
Rope gone I hewed
1 Row shnds on our
a 76 place show
& windy all day clear
by to night
Kild 4 Ducks today
1 old one 3 young ones
very nice

Sunday August 2
I wet up to the forks
off creek Hoops Back
found some spruce trees
got peramain showed
" 3 I turned over day
Percy was here for
dinner hunting Hoops
" 4 bowd spruce
It Rained some more &
I killed 4 mallards duck
showering this evening
" 5 I went to stons &
stayed till after dinner &
Percy came up & we
cocked hay after dinner
in the Potomac
" 6 We hauled spruce
on a log & place for
dinner turned hay after
dinner & cocked some
more hild 3 ducks

" 7 finished hawing &
cocking hay Percy
worked 2 1/2 days for
me I hild one duck &
Percy took it to stons
cloudy & Rane Bow to
night
" 8 I was on the sick
list today I wet after
Bear trap went to
stons after Pills I
took 7 Pills to eye
close Rained & Pm
very warm had peas
& Beans fore dinner
" 9 Sunday I am
feeling better cloudy
& windy Geo ston came
up hunting Hoops
Rained a little

August 10 Cloudy Role
Stone came up after the
Rake & I went down to
mow hay commenced to
mow hay after dinner
fore stone

" 11 Rained a little to
stop haying
Said in camp all day

" 12 cut hay

" 13 cut hay stone
Stacked Hay after dinner
Archie started for flying shott
at dinner showing

" 14 cut hay Robes team

" 15 cut hay windy & stormy
frost last night I fed
Archie Geo turned marks
soose and gun

" 16 my BIRTH day
frosty this morning &
Sear came up home

" 17 Picked Hay fore
Stone by the Bush

" 18 Picked Hay's day
cut hay after dinner
fore Road Stone
finished his

" 19 cut hay fore
Robert Stone day

" 20 I came home
with mow and
cut hay in upper Bottom

" 21 finished cutting
hay at 10 o'clock
and quit fore dinner
wet to stones after the
Rake & tea

" 22 Archie & Percy
came up and hauled
6 loads of hay from
Bunch hay in Bottom
to gran by Rake I killed
a trail duck & ate supper
tried to rain

August 23, 1908
Cloudy damp this
morning Rained Jersey
Brantons Hardin &
man from Oregon up
and they got the moving
machine

" 24 Rained Placed
lumber for door & started
to nudge door casing
with crescent saw
at 25 muddily door and
Home came Jersey came
up after dinner and
continued digging holes
for Barn

" 26 Set brotchis hanging
scales for Barn finished

" 27 Hauled sand &
dirt on Puff Rained
Nip to well the day
cloudy Rained evening

" 28 Rained in the
night we went to bed
dinner Rained after dinner
Read Brant's Primer
up Rained all night

" 29 Rained & made
winds casing & mouse
trap took some
& got out mares

" 30 muddled got a way
Pargy not home
an since clear this
morning warm

Rained at 3.0 Glock
Archey & Geo laid hear
and didn't stop to say
below Baked ginger bread

" 31 I took Hay rake
down to Mr Hardin's
Pursey cut tols cut
Brush on Barn hauled
Pals clear & frost

September 1908
11 1 Hauled 1000 lb in
hauled hay on Barn
fine cloudy & sprinkled
11 2 3/4 Wind hauled
hay on Barn & piled
grouse head Brant Beaf
up very windy & cloudy
11 3 Hauled hay &
finished Barn cut Lead
spine Poles for Bares
11 4 Rained this morning
& windy hot west wind
cursey knixed mud & I
dressed the house &
we went to stones
after supper stayed all
11 5 in stone & archery
& I went to flying shot
& stayed all night at
Cliford's

Sept 6 we went to
Breedens to attend
road meeting and
had dinner at Breedens
Went to Smith's &
stayed all night
I got seven letters this
11 7 Mr. A. L. Bick
Brant the mail I got
7 letters from Arnold
at Edmonton one
from Minnie England
we came back to
Revilion Bros and I
settled my account
with Furgerson the
Hudson Bay Co. \$1.06⁰⁰
Mr. Furgerson gave me
a fare Mackisins
and I welded wagon Rode
11 8 we came to stones
I had dinner at the
to Hardin by Reade

Sept 9 I came home a
foot but Jimindo
& lass Geo stone was
near fore dinner & party
Horsis south of creek
Mr Hardin Brauth
showing me hen home
to give him some
Beats Slim came
up with team
" 10 Slim bonned
diging Hay Pen Post
holes I went to lake
to cut hay after dinner
" 11 Slim & I went
to lake to cut hay
I kild 7 ducks &
Slim kild 4 grouse
Mr Bernard came
up with Rake &
Bill Read came
up to hunt ducks
we built Hay Pen

dinner
Sept 13 Slim & Read &
I wet to lake to make
Hay kild 4 ducks
Rained to wet to
make Hay
" 14 Slim & Read
kild 12 ducks & I
Rained I went out
on the lake Slim got
one shot in the head
" 15 Horsis broke loose
& I went after them
to wet to hay
16 Slim Raked some
Hay I kild 20 ducks
17 Read wet home
with 22 ducks Hauled
5 loads Hay I finished
Raking Read Slim
kild 5 ducks

Sept 18 Hauled 7 loads
off Jay Road came
back home windy
" 19 hauled 1 load to
top out stacks and
came home 100 block
Stone went down to
stones with pack
" 20 m stony & I
went to Saklone Lake
to attend Road meeting
Sept 21 Water eating
I went to cut poles
Pearre Boy told us
about seeing a Black
Bear we went to
hunt him on Riled
a Brown cow Bear
then hauled poles
very windy
" 22 came to stony
met Benson & Henshaw
a sacrament
stayed at stony

" 23 settled up with
me stony all accounts
except breaking
Archey came up and
we are getting ready
for a moose hunt
settled up with
Archey stone in full
Thursday Sept 24
Started for a moose
hunt camped at forks
Beaver Sadge Creek fore
dinner Beaver Indian
& family went with us
camped at another lake
over night ~~for~~ had
ducks
" Friday frosty
left off 1248 with stone
Lake left trail for
moose Ridge camp
by some fine Lake
moose base

" 26 Saturday
Indin turned back
and we came on
thru the Bush
to Mr Reynolds
place on Swan Lake
Bk Culumba

Sept 27 Sunday
Rained & Snowed
Mr Reynolds went
2 fish in net
Slim hunted geese

to Kowaska River
five mountain stream
Rained on us most
cell the way

home camped at forks
Beaver Indians game

my shack for dinner
went down to stoves
and archer come back
and stayed all night

" 7 Slims went
home & I dug spuds

" 8 I pulled carrots &
Beats & Onions

" 9 I went down to
Slims place after carrots
& Onions & Read Brant
me some
shot a mallard at
saw mill on wing

Oct 10 heavy frost
I went to Arnolds
place but could not
dig spuds with hove
at frosty Turnips
froze so I dug spuds
on Arnolds place

" 11 I went up a Round
Spruce grove I saw
moose track & 2 beaver
& beaver dam warm
clouding up this evening

" 12 dug spuds
warm held 1 duck

" 13 finished spuds
windy wet to
stoves & barney
came up and
hailed them on
held one duck

" 14 got ready
for Jack to
take to 3 ducks
to stoves

" 15 Stayed at
mead & Grants over
night at Lowes for
dinner Branded with
came home to stones
" 16 came home busy
up with team Pulled
Ratibegoo
Mr M Gogins
McDonald from
Duluth Minn USA
Mr Robinson from
Lester Slave Lake
Indian from crossing
Stayed all night
" 17 this last left
for sasaktunc lake
this morning frosty
1 Pulled turnips &
kild 2 presents & 4
Ducks

moose & Beavers
were at camp when
I got home gave a
Beas Diced moose

with them to stones

south side of creek

Geo Stone came up
I hauled turnips after
dinner

" 23 we went to
Lake & fenced hay
came home & hauled
1/2 loads wood

Over all cooler wind
I went to stones &
Brent Prince Back

" 25 Rained hard
I Piled dinner
I went up to the lake
found trail led me to
discovered Spruce Lake
1/2 miles East on D line
