

Finding a Legal Land Location

Land Description ___ $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section ___ - Township - Range - W ___ Meridian

To find a legal land location in an Alberta Road Atlas (published by MapArt), locate the Township number in the light grey vertical band on the right or left side of the page, and the Range number on the light grey horizontal band at the top or the bottom of the page. The square where these two bands intersect is the Township in which the legal description is located. Each township is a six mile square composed of 36 sections, normally intersected by North-South Range Roads every mile and East-West Township Roads every two miles, as follows:
